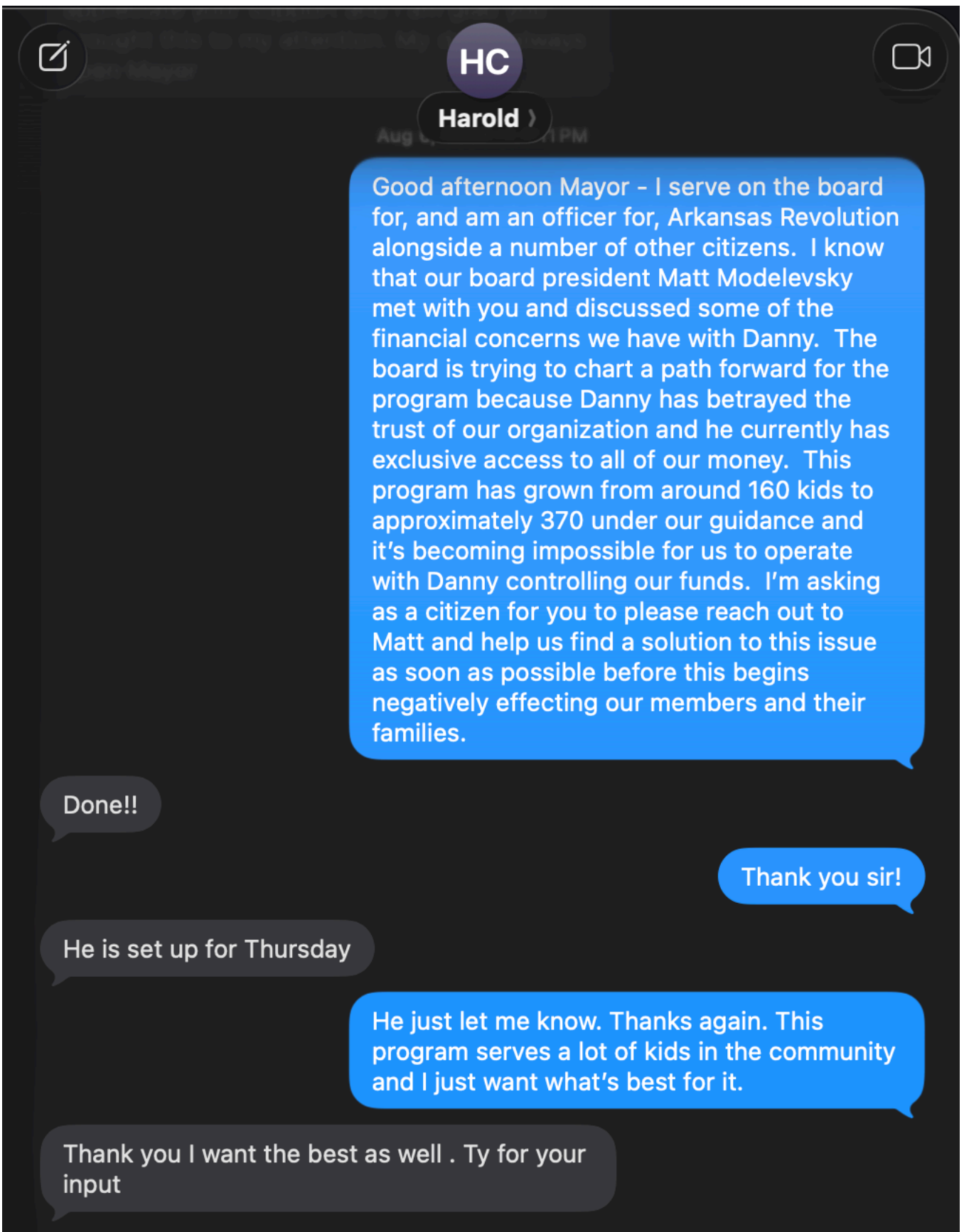


Harold Texts With Daniel

Yesterday we were informed that we have to give up access to the turf fields on our practice nights to make way for a new pee wee football program right in the middle of our season. We've been training out at Joe Mack for 10+ years and never had any issues with them until now all of a sudden. I can't help but feel this is Danny retaliating since he controls access to the fields.

We've got 400 families in Revolution and we are about to have to explain to them why we are being displaced. We offered the football people Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday and their response just reiterated the times and ccd Danny.

I apologize for starting your morning out like this, but I and the other board members are volunteering countless hours to provide a service to the city and we've got the largest youth sport in the area by far and growing every year. Please let me know what we can do, and I appreciate you taking the time to read this.
